

AIGUA - RELACIONS GEOLÒGIQUES D'AMOR

HORT-ART

This call is addressed to dancers and body arts professionals, to invite them to participate in the AIGUA- Relacions Geològiques d'Amor artistic residency program. This year's program includes five artistic research residencies, which will take place simultaneously in the towns of the Vall de Segó (Faura, Benifairó de les Valls, Quartell, Quart de les Valls and Benavites), from September 8 to 15 .

AIGUA-RGA invites artists to discover the hydraulic network that distributes the water of the Font de Quart, its natural and architectural heritage. Ditches, canals, watering holes, wash basins, cisterns, boulevards, ravines, deploy a complicated network that embraces the entire territory. The importance of these constructions and the collective memory of the territory will be the starting point to develop the different investigations created in residence.

For seven days, five artists will explore the body/space relationship.

An immersive experience, in which each selected project will be offered an outdoor space where they can develop their practices.

Hort-Art will offer artists, on the one hand, the necessary logistical support to develop the research and, on the other, artistic advice/coaching, trying to awaken or activate creative processes in relation to the environment.

The artists, for their part, will offer a workshop to the community and an open exhibition at the end of the process, in a work in progress format.



ARTISTISTIC RESIDENCIES AT LA VALL DE SEGÓ (VALENCIA)

Who?

The call is directed to...

- To dancers, choreographers, professionals in the field of contemporary dance and performing arts, interested in the dialogue of their artistic practice with the environment offered by a natural/ agricultural setting (outdoors) and the interaction with community.
- Projects will be individual.

When?

- The residencies will last eight consecutive days, in permanent residence, from September 8 to September 15, and simultaneously.

Where?

- La Vall de Segó: Faura, Benifairó de les Valls, Quartell, Quart de les Valls & Benavites.
- Spaces: Outdoor locations, site-specific, and the Escorxador (old slaughterhouse) of Faura and La Casa Gran de Faura.

What do we offer?

Hort-Art offers...

- Logistical and artistic support in field work at locations.
- Accompaniment sessions.
- Accommodation in the Casa Gran de Faura, in individual rooms, or in some other local accommodation.
- The use of shared kitchen, bathroom and work room spaces with internet access.

Economical support?

- Fees for artists €700.00 (VAT included)

What do artists commit to?

Artists commit to...

- Make responsible use of the facilities, following the guidelines established by the organizational team.
- Offer a workshop/activity for the community during the period of stay.
- Share the research, in “work in progress” sample format, at the end of the residency period.
- Sign a letter of commitment at the time of acceptance.
- Submit a report of the stay, using a form, at the end of the residency.

How to apply?

- Filling out a form: available until 11:59 p.m. on August 6, 2024, where you can provide a statement of motivation for participation in the project, the availability of dates and artistic career, providing links or audiovisual material.
- All applications will be evaluated and informed of the result of the selection process.
- Maximum publication date of the selection: August 11, 2024.
- Even so, before the start of the project, the organization and the artists will meet in person or telematically to clarify any questions.
